RECOMMENDED MOTION:

That Council approve the Dust Suppression rates as presented and direct administration to amend the Master Rates Bylaw to include these rates.



RELEVANT LEGISLATION:

Provincial (cite)- N/A

Council Bylaw/Policy (cite)- Kneehill County Policy #13-4.

BACKGROUND/PROPOSAL:

Kneehill County Dust Suppression Policy 13-4 details that rates for the spec crude and calcium applications will be set based on product costs as of March in the current year. The 2024 product costs for calcium and spec crude are comparable to 2023 costs.

The proposed 2024 rates for Calcium Dust Suppression are as follows:

	2023 Rate	2024 Rate
Full Calcium Chloride (2 Applications)	\$10.50 / metre	\$10.00 / metre
Top Spray Calcium (1 Application)	\$5.25 / metre	\$5.00 / metre
Spec Crude	\$62.00 / metre	\$56.00 / metre





DISCUSSION/OPTIONS/BENEFITS/DISADVANTAGES/OTHER CONSIDERATIONS:

A thorough cost analysis was performed on the 2023 Dust Control program. With the additional tracking of gravel and dust control product volumes, equipment, and labour hours, a more detailed estimate of costs per metre has been developed.

There were 14 kms of ratepayer paid calcium chloride dust control applications in 2023, with a total volume of 290,000 litres of calcium applied. There were also 1.5 kms of spec crude applied.

The costs to supply and install the calcium chloride are as follows:

Total	\$10.00 per lineal metre \$3.04 per foot
Equipment/labour	\$3.63 per lineal metre
Gravel cost	\$4.47 per lineal metre
Calcium Chloride product cost	\$1.90 per lineal metre

The costs to supply and install the spec crude are as follows:

Total	\$56.00 per lineal metre \$17.07 per foot
Kneehill County Equipment/labour	\$9.77 per lineal metre
Gravel cost	\$4.47 per lineal metre
Contractor equipment and product	\$41.76 per lineal metre

FINANCIAL & STAFFING IMPLICATIONS:

Dust abatement products mitigate the impact of dust on properties located adjacent to gravel roads within the County. Maintaining these rates as close to true cost will allow more residents the option of participating in the program.
