Project Costs

- Total project cost is projected at \$8M to \$9M
 - The lack of adequate water supply requires the project to drill a well, install an underground holding tank and construct multiple firewalls.
 - Installation of a sprinkler system is cost prohibitive as it requires a larger holding tank, a backup generator, fire pumps and potentially additional wells.
 - The lack of sanitary services requires the installation of a septic tank or septic field incurring an initial cost as well as ongoing operation costs.
