

BYLAW NO. 1907

REDESIGNATION FROM DIRECT CONTROL 5 DISTRICT TO AGRICULTURE DISTRICT

BEING A BYLAW OF THE COUNCIL OF KNEEHILL COUNTY, IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, TO AMEND
LAND USE BYLAW NO. 1808

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Municipal Government Act, Chapter M-26, Revised Statutes of Alberta 2000, as amended, a Municipal Council has authority to govern and to pass bylaws respecting the municipality; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed necessary and expedient to amend Bylaw No. 1808 in the manner hereinafter.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of Kneehill County, in the Province of Alberta, duly assembled, and under the powers conferred upon it by the Municipal Government Act, RSA 2000, Chapter M-26, and amendment thereto, enacts as follows:

1. THAT in PART XIV- LAND USE MAPS, the relevant 1,224 m² of Ptn. SE 18-30-24 W4M shown on the sketch below are to be redesignated from Direct Control District 5 to A- Agriculture District.



This land was redesignated originally on October 22, 2019 from Agriculture to Direct Control 5 (Bylaw 1803). Bylaw 1907 reverts the land back to its original designation.

2. EFFECTIVE DATE

(1) This bylaw comes into effect upon third reading.
