BACKGROUND/PROPOSAL:

The commitment to Health and Safety in our County is robust. To ensure that we as an organization are in compliance with legislation implemented by the Government of Alberta, reviews of applicable Health and Safety Policies and Procedures are conducted as per organizational timeframes and if changes to legislation impact the effectiveness of these documents.

Changes to the past 17-1 Kneehill County Safety Policy were considered due to the External COR Audit conducted in October 2024. The external auditor recommended that "The Health and Safety Policy should be updated to meet current audit requirements for all employees to be required to comply with applicable OHS legislation, not just be familiar with it", additions to the health and safety responsibilities of the Chief Administrative Officer and Directors were added to further define senior leadership's roles and provide accountability at this level.
